Rahul launches yatra; says Tricolour under attack

LAUNCHING HIS BHARAT Jodo Yatra from Kanyakumari to Kashmir, which will see him walk across 12 states, covering 3,570 kilometres over a period of 150 days, senior Congress leader Rahul Gandhi on Wednesday said "every single institution", including the national flag, is "under attack by the BJP and RSS".

Addressing a seaside public meeting, Rahul focused on the Tricolour to counter the BJP's nationalism pitch. It is not enough to just salute the national flag, it is important to defend the ideas and values behind the flag, he said.

He said the Tricolour represents every Indian — the religion of every single person, state and language of the country. It does not belong to any particular religion or community, he said. The flag offers protection to every Indian, guarantees a free and fair life to every citizen, and the right to practice any religion and speak any language, he said.

"Today, this flag is under attack. India is not the imposition of one idea in its people. India is the history, the language, the culture of every single person. India is the institutions which protect this flag.

India is a free media that protects this flag. India is the judiciary that protects this flag. And today, every single institution is under attack by the BJP and RSS. Before addressing the public meeting, Rahul received the national flag from Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M K Stalin at the Mahatma Gandhi Mandapam here.

I-T comes knocking: 100 premises; also think tank CPR, NGO Oxfam

THE INCOMETAX Department on Wednesday conducted "surveys" on the premises of think tank Centre for Policy Research (CPR) and global non-profit organisation Oxfam.

The action came on the day tax authorities conducted nationwide searches at over 100 locations spread across states including Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Haryana, Gujarat and Delhi.

The tax searches, a senior official said, were being conducted as part of action against some registered unrecognised political parties.

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The CPR is a non-profit, non-partisan, independent institution focusing on research, while Oxfam is a British-founded non-profit organisation that works to support child education, empowerment of women and the fight against inequality in India.

The Income Tax Act empowers officials to enter any premises of the assessee, such as residences, shops, factories or offices for a search-and-seizure operation.

"Some of these searches against political parties are linked to each other across states and some searches have no link to each other. The tax authorities are conducting searches across 100-plus locations and follow-up action and probe will continue in the coming days also," the official said.

Surveys, which are conducted under Section 133A of the Income Tax Act, take place only on business premises. Surveys start during normal business hours, whereas searches can be conducted any time of the day.

Mindtree to set up development centre in Kolkata: CEO

MINDTREE, A LARSEN & Toubro Group company, is planning to set up a development centre in Kolkata, which could create employment opportunities for 15,000-20,000 people in the next four-five years, a company official said here on Wednesday.

The IT services firm has already onboarded 1,700 people in its existing facility in the West Bengal capital so far, he said.

"We have taken up 19 acres of space. Hopefully, things will start. The construction will be done by L&T... the management is committed. We will set up a huge centre," Mindtree chief executive officer and managing director Debashis Chatterjee said at ICT East organised by CII.

The development centre can create employment opportunities for 15,000-20,000 people, he said.

The IT company had in March announced the opening of its first development centre in Kolkata. Another IT company of the L&T group, Larsen and Toubro Infotech (ITI) had in June also announced opening up of a new centre in the eastern metropolis.

Larsen and Toubro board had in May announced a composite scheme of amalgamation of its two listed IT services firms to create a combined entity.

Ukraine, pandemic hit global supply chains: PM at Russia meet

WITH RUSSIAN PRESIDENT Vladimir Putin listening, Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Wednesday said the Ukraine conflict and the Covid pandemic have had a "major impact" on global supply chains, leading to shortages of foodgrains, fertilisers and fuels.

In an online plenary session address at the Eastern Economic Forum — being held in the Russian city of Vladivostok and also attended by Putin — Modi, without mentioning the Russian invasion, said India has stressed the need to pursue diplomacy and dialogue "since the beginning of the Ukraine conflict".

India's "ancient doctrine of Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam has taught us to see the world as a family, and in today's globalised world, events in one part of the world create an impact on the whole world," said Modi. "The Ukraine conflict and the Covid pandemic have had a major impact on global supply chains. Shortages of foodgrains, fertilisers and fuels are a major concern for developing countries. Since the beginning of the Ukraine conflict, we have stressed the need to take the path of diplomacy and dialogue... We support all peaceful efforts to end this conflict," he said.

Modi said India welcomes the recent agreement regarding the safe export of cereals and fertilisers. "India is keen to strengthen its partnership with Russia on Arctic issues. There is also immense potential for cooperation in the field of energy. Along with energy, India has also made significant investments in the Russian Far East in the areas of pharma and diamonds," he said.

His comments come in the backdrop of concerns raised by the West, including the US and Europe, over countries buying oil from Russia. Ukraine has criticised India for buying Russian oil. Defending the decision, India has said it is buying oil to meet energy needs and minimise the inflationary impact.

On Wednesday, Modi said Russia can become an important partner for the Indian steel industry with the supply of coking coal, and there is scope for cooperation in the mobility of talent. "Indian talent has contributed to the development of many developed regions of the world. I believe that the talent and professionalism of Indians can bring about rapid development in the Russian Far East," he said.

Recalling his participation at the forum summit in 2019, Modi said India had announced its "Act Far-East" policy at that time, as a result of which its cooperation with the Russian Far East had increased in various fields. "This policy has now become a key pillar of the Special and Privileged Strategic Partnership between India and Russia," he said. "This month itself, 30 years are being completed since the establishment of the Consulate of India

in Vladivostok. India was the first country to open a consulate in this city. Since then, this city has been witness to many milestones in our relationship," he said.

Modi said the Eastern Economic Forum, established in 2015, has become a major global forum for international cooperation in the development of the Russian Far East. "For this, I appreciate President Putin's vision and also congratulate him," he said.

About the International North-South Corridor, the Chennai-Vladivostok Maritime Corridor and the Northern Sea Route, Modi said: "Connectivity will play an important role in the development of our relations in the future."

Organised by The Roscongress Foundation, the Eastern Economic Forum describes itself as a key international platform for establishing and strengthening ties within the Russian and global investment communities, and for comprehensive expert evaluation of the economic and investment potential of the Russian Far East. The forum was established by the decree of President Putin in 2015 to support the economic development of Russia's Far East and to expand international cooperation in the Asia-Pacific region.
